

## MCHA Skill Management and Evaluation

Players,

The MCHA is committed to provide the highest quality hockey experience for players 18 years and over at most skill and experience levels. We do this through a couple of mechanisms:

**Evaluations:** The MCHA has developed a hockey skill-based evaluation system which is utilized to determine each player's overall hockey level. These evaluations define which divisions (D, C, Elite-C) each player is eligible to play in.

In the event that a player is deemed to exceed the skill level of their current division, the MCHA reserves the right to move the player to a team/division where his/her skill is more appropriate. If the player chooses to decline such a move, the MCHA and our partner rinks are not liable for any refund.

**Rule Modifications:** The MCHA utilizes a goal scoring cap system to further enhance our ability to achieve division by division parity. No player in any MCHA division may exceed 3 goals per game.

The MCHA reserves the right to adjust this limit midway through the season to ensure equitable play.
