2011 Guidelines for Player Experience Limits per Division

Classifications for Highest Level Hockey Experience:

1. Adult League - Instructional
2. Adult League - Learned Hockey as an Adult
3. Youth Recreational
4. Youth Travel
5. High School Junior Varsity
6. College Club Roller Hockey
7. High School Varsity
8. College Club Hockey
9. Juniors
10. College Scholarship
11. Professional

E League

1. Typically, new players to the sport of ice and/or roller hockey.
2. Player Experience Limit: Adult League - Instructional

D2 League

1. Typically, players who learned hockey as an adult.
2. Player Experience Limit:
 - a. Youth Recreational: Minimum Age - 28
 - b. Youth Travel: Minimum Age - 45
 - c. High School Junior Varsity: Minimum Age - 45
 - d. College Club Roller Hockey: Minimum Age - 50
 - e. High School Varsity : Minimum Age - 50
 - f. College Club Hockey: Minimum Age - 50
 - g. Juniors: Minimum Age - 60
 - h. College Scholarship: Minimum Age - 60
 - i. Professional: Minimum Age - Not Eligible

D1 League

1. Typically, players who learned hockey as an adult or older adults who played in their youth.
2. Player Experience Limit:
 - a) Youth Recreational: Minimum Age - 18
 - b) Youth Travel: Minimum Age - 30
 - c) High School Junior Varsity: Minimum Age - 30
 - d) College Club Roller Hockey: Minimum Age - 45
 - e) High School Varsity : Minimum Age - 45

2011 Guidelines for Player Experience Limits per Division

- f) College Club Hockey: Minimum Age - 45
- g) Juniors: Minimum Age - 60
- h) College Scholarship: Minimum Age - 60
- i) Professional: Minimum Age - 65

C League

1. Typically, players who played organized hockey in their youth.
2. Player Experience Limit:
 - a) Youth Travel: Minimum Age - 18
 - b) High School Junior Varsity: Minimum Age - 18
 - c) College Club Roller Hockey: Minimum Age - 27
 - d) High School Varsity: Minimum Age - 27
 - e) College Club Hockey: Minimum Age - 40
 - f) Juniors: Minimum Age - 45
 - g) College Scholarship: Minimum Age - 50
 - h) Professional: Minimum Age - 55

B League

1. Typically, players who played organized hockey at a high level.
2. A limited of 2 players under the age of 35, with either professional or college scholarship experience.
3. Player Experience Limit:
 - a) Juniors: Minimum Age - 18
 - b) College Scholarship: Minimum Age - 18
 - c) Professional: Minimum Age - 18

To help facilitate the ministry objectives of the MCHA, we understand the value of establishing skill parameters for each division. These are only guidelines to assist placing players in the appropriate division. These guidelines will be used in conjunction with the MCHA Player Evaluation Criteria document.
